You will be responsible for grading 5 of your peers' books and their public reading. Be fair and be honest. During class you are not to share your grade with that student. Score students a 3 (excellent), 2 (good), 1 (poor) or 0 (missing) for each category in the space to the left of each item listed.

1. Book included the following:

- ___ A book bound creatively
- ___ Decorated Cover with original title and author's name, plus an illustration or piece of artwork
- ___ Title page, complete with original title of the book, author's name and publisher's name (typed)
- ___ Dedication page (typed)
- ___ Table of contents (typed)
- ___ About the Author (typed)
- ___ 4 myths and legends, plus illustrations (typed)
- ___ 4 autobiographies (typed)
- ___ 1 evaluation essay (typed)
- ___ Back cover opinion blurbs (typed)
- ___ **TOTAL out of 30 possible points**

(At least 2 or more of these included in the book.) Score them the same way. The total may be more than the total possible.

- ___ An illustration for each autobiography
- ___ An illustration for each evaluation essay
- ___ An acknowledgments page (typed)
- ___ A quote by another author that imparts some words of wisdom that fit with your book (typed)
- ___ A foreword written by a peer, signed by them, and placed before your table of contents (typed)
- ___ **Total out of 6 points possible**

2. Public Reading included the following:

- ___ A brief introduction that includes who the author is, the title of the book, the title of their selected reading, what journey their book reflects and how it is a reflection of that journey
- ___ Eye contact with the audience
- ___ Pauses used to emphasize phrases, words and ideas
- ___ Emotions used to emphasize phrases, words and ideas
- ___ Speaking softly or loudly to emphasize phrases, words and ideas
- ___ Standing, sitting or moving around to help dramatize the piece
- ___ The book held and displayed while reading
- ___ A selection whose content caught and held the audience's attention
- ___ A selection that was either a myth, an autobiography, or an evaluation
- ___ **TOTAL out of 27 possible**
