## HOMWORK QUESTIONS LESSON 26

**Directions:** Answer the following questions in the space provided. If you need extra room, use the back of this page.

1. Since "PRISON SYSTEM" is two words (in toc.html), the space between the two letters is underlined. This is ugly. How would you fix this problem?

**ANSWER:**

```
<A HREF="fontimg.html#prison">PRISON</a> <A  
HREF="fontimg.html#prison">SYSTEM</a><BR>
```

2. How might you make a picture act like a button so that if you clicked on it, it would link to another page?

**ANSWER:**

```
<A HREF="anotherpage.html"><IMG SRC="picture"></A>
```

3. If we moved the <BR> tags *inside* the <A>...</A> tag in toc.html, would it look any different in your web browser? Why?

**ANSWER:**

No, because <BR> is a *non-printing* tag, that does not affect the behavior of the ANCHOR tag.

4. What would the following HTML do?

```
Go to <A HREF="#partsix"> PART SIX</A><BR>
```

```
Go to <A HREF="#partseven">PART SEVEN</A><BR>
```

**ANSWER:**

It would turn the words "PART SIX" and "PART SEVEN" into links that would take the user to ANCHORS named "partsix" and "partseven" *in the same document...* assuming that elsewhere in the document there were tags such as the following:

```
<A NAME=partsix>
```

```
...
```

```
<A NAME=partseven>
```

5. How would you modify fontimg.html such that there is a way to get back to toc.html? Not everyone makes use of the "BACK" button on their browser, so it is always a good idea to have a way of backtracking through the websites that you build.

**ANSWER:**

Create a text link to **toc.html** after each section of **fontimg.html**.
