

SECTION WEB PAGE REQUIREMENTS

DIRECTIONS

Today, you will start making a web page that is your submission for the online newspaper. As you design the page, keep in mind the types of features included in your newspaper section, as well as your theme and your target audience. Write down your theme and your target audience in the space below:

You must include the following criteria on your web page:

TEXT

- Page title (The name of your section of the newspaper)
- Subheadings or Subtitles (The titles of the pieces you are including on the page)
- Hooks- pieces of the text for each subtitle
- Links – remember a good site is easily navigable!
 - 1) 4 links to the actual text of the subtitled pieces from each of your group members. You do not have these pieces now. So you will create placeholders for the three you do not have, but you will create the standard layout using the one piece you do have, your own. You do not want to include the entire text of each piece on the section page. You want to tease/entice your audience to read the whole piece. Remember that web browsers get bored easily. So too much text is annoying and they will just leave your site.
 - 2) homepage link
 - 3) links to all other sections of your site
- 4 Pieces of Newswriting – The writing should be the piece you have been revising over the past few days. If you are designing the political cartoons section, the “writing” will be an image with text included. There must be three other pieces of writing that you grab from the Internet and place with your piece (i.e. three other cartoons, or book reviews, or editorials, or letters). These will be the place holders for the rest of your group members pieces that will be submitted to you once the editorial staff for each team has been chosen. Make sure you include the name of the author with each piece.
- A bulleted or numbered list

DESIGN AND NAVIGATION

- Color scheme (not the standard Netscape color scheme) – choose different colors for your background, your writing, and your links. Remember to maintain consistency (make all links the same color, for example), so that your site is easy to navigate.
- White space (blank areas on the page)
- At least one example each of bold and italic text
- Different font sizes
- Different font styles
- At least four images
- A recurring graphic element (a button or design, for example)
- At least one design element based on an idea you liked and listed in your Visual and Navigational Design Worksheet
