MULTICULTURALISM UNIT 1 FINAL EXAM

For this final exam you will have to write an Interpretation Essay on another student's Final Project. In order to do this you will need to do two things:

1. Demonstrate your knowledge of Latino history in California by using it to examine, analyze and interpret your peer's Coat of Arms. You will need to refer to individuals, individual groups, key events and important places in order to adequately support your interpretation, as well as exhibit what you have learned throughout this course. Please be as specific as possible in the evidence that you supply and be sure to mention things that are not included in the Coat of Arms that you are examining.
2. Show that you can write an Interpretation Essay in the correct format. This means you will need to demonstrate that you know how to structure and develop your essay in an organized and thoughtful way. Use the strategies that we have followed in class (the essay organizer) to help you design and build your essay.
3. Spelling and punctuation do count! So be sure to re-read your essay and check for mistakes.

Your teacher will pass out the Final Project you are to interpret. You may not trade with anyone else. Once you have been given a project, that is the one you must interpret. When you have your project, you may begin your exam.
