

RE-VISION

The purpose of re-vision is to help students to understand that good writers make changes to improve their writing pieces. It is to familiarize students with the process of drafting a quality piece of writing. Re-vision helps students learn the value of feedback and teaches them how to critique writing in a positive way.

You are aiming towards the idea that revision is seeing their papers again in a new and different way. Tell them that all writers make changes to their pieces in order to make them better. Explain to students that when re-visioning, they are only re-visioning content or ideas. The reason for this is simple; since they will be changing so much of their content as they go through the process, any changes made to spelling, punctuation or grammar will probably have to be changed again when they rewrite each draft. It is better to wait until the content is set before spending a lot of time editing a paper.
