SKETCH TOPIC: WISDOM'S GROWTH SKETCH # 22

The goal of the Wisdom's Growth sketch is to...record students' interest in Smithsonian exhibits and their ideas on the impact museums have on future generations' understanding.

Step 3
After reading about the Smithsonian, students should write an opinion on the museum's representation of America in the rain cloud.

Step 1
As quads read through exhibit cards and examine floor plans of the Smithsonian, each student should select 5 exhibits which capture their curiosity. The title of the exhibits should be written across each raindrop.

Step 2
As time permits during review of the Smithsonian materials, students should write an explanation of what makes them curious about each of the exhibits they selected in the area radiating around each raindrop.

Step 4
The growing vine on this sketch page is representative of students' wisdom growth. In the area around the vine, instruct students to write a self examination of what wisdom they hope to leave as their legacy.
